A PLACE TO CALL HOME



The beautiful City of Owen Sound honors the history, spirituality, and culture of the Anishinaabe peoples on whose traditional territories we live today and whose ancestors signed Treaties with ours.

Owen Sound is on the southern shore of Georgian Bay, in a valley beneath the limestone cliffs of the Niagara Escarpment, at the foot of the Bruce Peninsula, known for its exceptional geography. Called the Scenic City, Owen Sound features an expansive harbor and bay, winding rivers, tree-lined streets, extensive parks and trails, and a thriving historic downtown. As the largest urban community in Grey County, it holds the seat of government, supporting regional, provincial, and federal offices, a regional hospital, and a campus of Georgian College. Key natural attractions include Inglis Falls, Harrison Park, Kelso Beach Park, and several conservation areas. The Bruce Trail forms a ribbon around the city along the escarpment, connecting waterfalls and showcasing a wide array of flora and fauna, including rare ferns.
