Reality: Fixed-rate mortgages offer stability, while adjustable-rate mortgages (ARMs) have lower initial rates and can save money for buyers planning to sell or refinance before the rate adjusts.

Tip: Consider your long-term plans; an ARM may be cost-effective if you stay in the home for less than 5-7 years. Always compare total costs over the loan's life.

Reality: Refinancing is possible within the first year if financially beneficial, such as when interest rates drop or credit scores improve.

Tip: Use a mortgage calculator to estimate refinancing savings, considering closing costs to ensure savings exceed expenses.

Reality: Lenders might approve higher amounts than you can comfortably afford, risking financial strain.

Tip: Make a detailed budget covering all homeownership costs and keep your mortgage payment at 25-30% of your monthly income for flexibility.

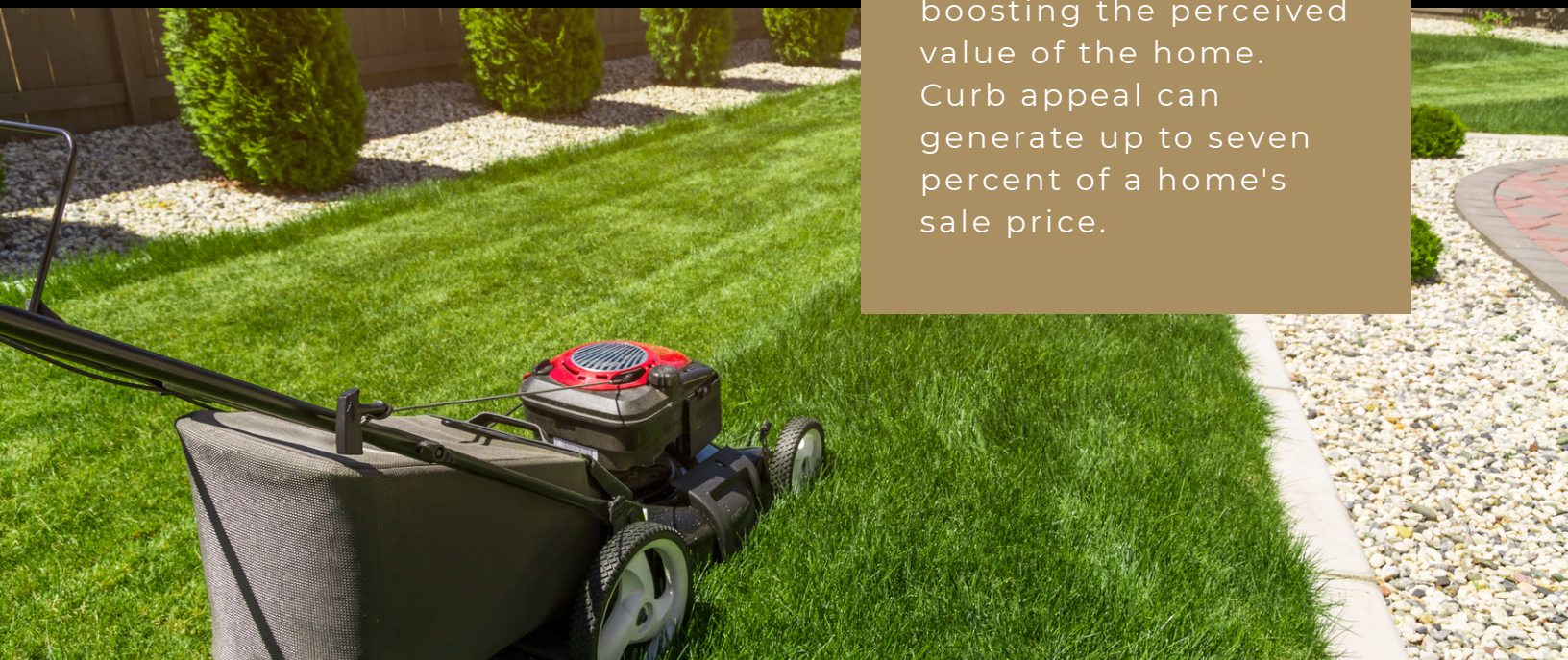
